



Scholarship FAQs

“Knowledge is power!”

1. Do I have to register for classes before applying?

No, if selected then you’ll be required to submit a schedule before the start of each semester.

2. I received the scholarship last year, can I apply again? *Yes. As long as you are or will be enrolled in a program that qualifies for Title IV funding (eligible to award federal financial aid whether you receive it or not).*

3. I haven’t decided where I’m attending, can I apply? *Yes. We know that many high school seniors may be on a waitlist or still deciding, you can apply & if selected tell us where you will be attending at a later date.*

4. Is the scholarship specific to my major?

No, but we are interested in your passion & we are an organization committed to service to others so we’d like to know about how you are applying those values in college or plan to.

5. I don’t have my grades yet, can I apply?

We ask for a transcript but this is not a strictly academic award. The essay weighs more than your grades. You can submit your most recent high school transcript (final or through first semester) or most recent college transcript (fall grades). We are aware the spring semester is in session.
